One of the many solutions was to allow people to type notes on their computers, which would cause less confusion with spelling, handwriting, and pages. However, we came up with a simple solution to that problem. There is an extension that allows teachers to look at what the students are on.

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Supplies Needed: 1 picture frame, 1 piece of flat glass that can fit the picture frame, 1 bottle of clear glue, food coloring, popsicle sticks, palette, and paint brushes.

- 1. Remove the glass from the picture frame carefully.**
- 2. clean the glass with glass cleaner or soap and water to get rid of dirt/smudges.**
- 3. Put a little amount of clear glue in a small container or palette.**
- 4. Put 3 drops of any food coloring colors you like into the clear glue and mix with a popsicle stick.**

5. Make sure your paintbrush is dry before you paint.

6. Optional: you can put black puffy paint as outlines to make it pop out more. Then let it dry for a couple of hours before painting.

7. You're ready to paint, remember to be creative!

8. Let your piece dry. Once it dries, hold it up to the sun or a bright light and see the beautiful, vibrant colors.

9. Put the painted glass inside the picture frame carefully and now you can use it as a room decoration and show family members or friends. Enjoy!
