

SHCHS Class of 1968 Scholarship Applications Instructions

Criteria

- The applicant must be a high school senior attending Southern Huntingdon County High School.
- The Scholarship must be used to further the students post-high school education at a recognized institution offering a post high school curriculum, such as college or university, technical school or specialty training school.
- Achievement, leadership abilities, extracurricular activities, and community service shall be considered in selection of the scholarship recipient.
- There shall be no discrimination in the selection of the recipient based on gender, race, or religion.

Applicants should pay close attention to the following instructions:

- Provide detailed and specific answers to all items in the student application form.
- Remember to attach essay regarding community service experiences and how they have impacted your development
- Attach two recommendations from teachers
- Attach one recommendation from a minister employer, or other adult non- family member who is acquainted with you through non- school activity.
- Recommendations must be included in the completed application packet.
- Completed applications must be received by the high school counselor by **March 25, 2021**—NO EXCEPTIONS
- Any applications received after this date will not be considered.
- Incomplete applications will be not accepted.
