## Academic Choir Requirements (6-12th Grade):

### Things All Students Must Buy:

- A 1-inch or 1.5-inch, 3-ring, black binder with interior pockets and no markings on the outside (name tags for the inside cover of this binder will be provided by Mr. Aujay on day 1)
- A 3-ring pencil pouch to put inside the student binder which will include the following:
  - Multiple pencils for marking scores
  - At least 1 highlighter
  - At least 1 black ink pen
- Pack of 6 plastic dividers for binders

## Students Planning to Audition for Select Choirs (6-12th Grade):

### Things All Students Must Buy:

- All items listed above (1.5 inch black binder preferred)
- Students should be prepared to purchase this year's choir t-shirt (details provided once school has started) as it will be required for both middle school and high school select ensembles as the casual uniform (available via the choir merch shop)

### Vocal Tech Students:

- A 1.5-inch or 2-inch, 3-ring, binder with interior pockets (name tags for the inside cover of this binder will be provided by Mr. Aujay on day 1)
- A 3-ring pencil pouch to put inside the student binder which will include the following:
  - Multiple pencils for marking scores
  - At least 1 highlighter
  - At least 1 black ink pen
- Pack of 6 plastic dividers for binders

### Intro to Theater Students:

- A 2-inch, 3-ring, binder with interior pockets (name tags for the inside cover of this binder will be provided by Mr. Aujay on day 1)
- A 3-ring pencil pouch to put inside the student binder which will include the following:
  - Multiple pencils for marking scores
  - At least 1 highlighter
  - At least 1 black ink pen
- Pack of 6 plastic dividers for binders

### Guitar/Piano Students:

- A 1-inch or 1.5-inch, 3-ring, binder with interior pockets and no markings on the outside (name tags for the inside cover of this binder will be provided by Mr. Aujay on day 1)
- A 3-ring pencil pouch to put inside the student binder which will include the following:
  - Multiple pencils for marking scores & completing worksheets
  - At least 1 highlighter
  - At least 1 black ink pen
- Pack of 6 plastic dividers for binders

## Students Planning to Audition for This Year's Musical:

Students should be prepared to make the following purchases, though no purchases should be made until auditions conclude and the final cast list is posted. This information will be given in a hand out as well once each student accepts their assigned role.

- A 2-inch or 2.5-inch, 3-ring, binder with interior pockets (name tags for the inside cover of this binder will be provided by Mr. Aujay at the first rehearsal)
- A 3-ring pencil pouch to put inside the student binder which will include the following:
  - Multiple pencils for marking scores & Scripts
  - At least 1 highlighter
  - At least 1 black ink pen
- Pack of 6 plastic dividers for binders
- Character shoes (for ladies) or black/brown dress shoes (for gentlemen) unless otherwise specified by the costuming director.
- Makeup (one shade darker than your skin tone due to stage lighting)
- Makeup applicators (not to be shared with anyone but yourself)
- This year's musical t-shirt (available via the choir merch shop)
- One case of water, per student, to be stored in the chorus room and consumed during rehearsals/performances
- One box of tissues or roll of paper towels to be stored in the classroom

**PLEASE NOTE:** Other expenses may arise throughout production. These expenses will be communicated with enough time to make arrangements and will be given with flexible deadlines.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Participation in the SHC Musical may require student fundraising efforts. All students are expected to participate in at least one fundraising endeavor.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The SHC Musical should not be cost prohibitive.
